Please note: there will be a \$50.00 LATE PAYMENT FEE to cover the additional cost and burden of processing any renewals received after December 16th. So please make sure we receive your Renewal Coupon and payment by the stated due date to avoid this penalty.

One additional reminder: if you use Bill Pay or a similar service, please make sure you have the correct return address as: Park Shore Association, P.O. Box 9552, Naples, FL 34101-9552.

We anticipate the 2020 Beach Passes and Membership Directory to be distributed by your local Block Captain or Building Manager around mid- to late January. Until then, your 2019 Beach Pass will remain valid. Also, please note that the Park Shore Association will NOT mail Beach Passes to members.

Approximately 50 entries were received for this year's photo contest. Based on this success, we plan to hold another competition in the fall of 2020.

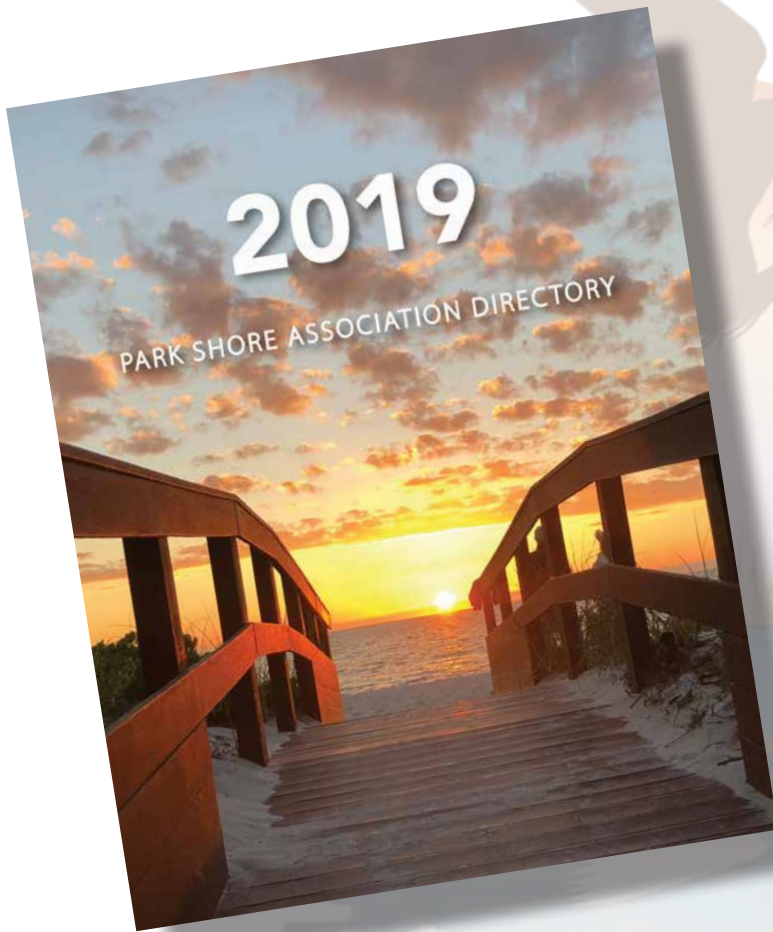
County Beach Renourishment Project Underway

On Sept. 24, 2019, the Board of County Commissioners approved the 2019 Beach Renourishment Project. Contract 19-7654 was awarded to Earth Tech Enterprises, Inc., to haul and place sand on Park Shore, North Park Shore and Clam Pass beaches. Stewart Mining in Immokalee will provide sand for the project through a separate existing material supply contract.

The project will utilize the Horizon Way beach access to place half of the sand on the southern half of the project and the Gulf Shore Beach pedestrian access to place the remaining half of the sand via conveyor on the north end of the project. Hours of operations will be seven days a week from sunrise to sunset. It is anticipated that the entire project will be complete by January 1, 2020.
