Deadline extended for 2020 U.S. Census

The deadline for the 2020 U.S. census survey has been extended to October 31st, according to a news release from the Census Bureau.



It is very important to our state and for our citizens that everyone is counted so that our state counts! Unfortunately, the COVID-19 Pandemic has greatly reduced the state's ability to collect responses in person and so officials are working to collect additional responses.

If you haven't filled out the census, you can do so in one of three ways:

- Online: Go to www.My2020Census.gov and click "start questionnaire." The web site will ask for a Census ID. If you don't have one, click the link below the space for the ID number.
- Mail: Those who received a survey in the mail can respond by sending the completed survey to the U.S. Census Bureau, 1201 E. 10th St., Suite 100, Jeffersonville, IN, 47190.
- Phone: Call 844-330-2020 for English and 844-468-2020 for Spanish.
